Prerequisite for Course:

- DEMP Textbook: \$42
- Current CPR Validation - Such as PADI's Emergency First Responder Course
- Be at least 12 years of age
- Scuba Certification is NOT required

Course Content:

- DAN O2: Oxygen Equipment Identification; Assembly & Reassembly; Rescue Breathing on Two Conscious & Unconscious Divers; Demand Valve Mask; Non-Rebreather Mask; Injured Diver Scenarios.
- HAZARDOUS MARINE LIFE INJURIES - HMLI: Identify HMLI; Recognize possible injuries caused by these animals; Provide First-Aid to HMLI Injuries; Techniques to avoid Hazardous Marine Life Injuries.
- AED DEFIBRILLATOR TRAINING: Recognize signs of Sudden Cardiac Arrest; Administer Basic Life Support using Automated External Defibrillators while activating local EMS to arrange transport to nearest medical facility.
- ADVANCED OXYGEN FIRST AID FOR SCUBA DIVING INJURIES: This Advanced level of Oxygen Administration trains current DAN O2 (within 12 months) Providers to use the MTV-100 or Bag Valve Masks to provide care for Non-Breathing Injured Divers.
