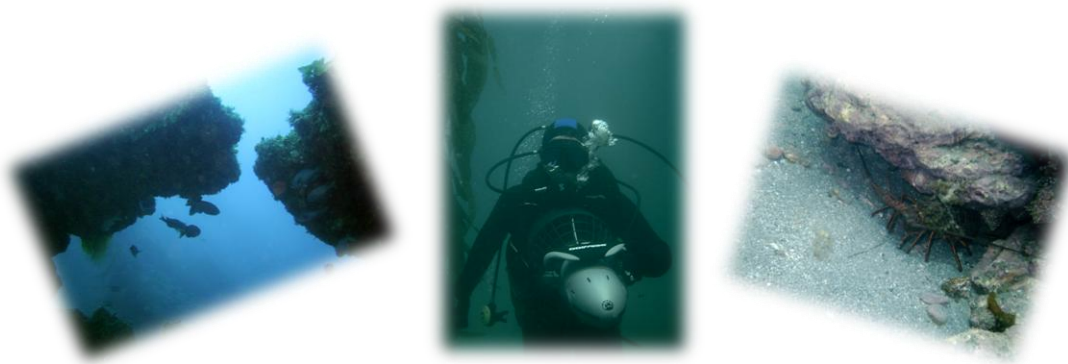


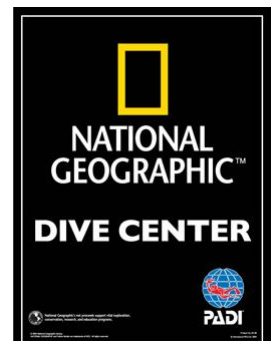


Specialty Diver Course



The various Specialty Diver Courses offered are an exciting way for certified divers to gain practical knowledge and experience in a specific diving activity. These courses provide the participant with a high-impact program that emphasizes both formal knowledge development and practical diving. Each course allows the participant to gain an in-depth understanding of a specific activity in recreational diving activities, while focusing on the fun of actually diving.

Additionally, five specialty diver certifications are required to attain the highest recreational certification rating in the PADI Diver program: *Master Scuba Diver*

Required Materials:

- PADI Specialty Textbook for selected Course: **\$36 - \$80**
- Compass, Timing Device, Dive Knife, Slate and Whistle, Dive Reel, Primary Dive Light, Back-Up Light, and Tank Light Stick – Are just a few items you may need depending on your Specialty Course.

Recommended Gear:

- For class dives, you must supply a Total Scuba Diving System including: BCD, Regulator, Alternate Air Source, Dive Computer or Submersible Pressure Gauge. , At this level you should own your own gear, but this equipment may be rented.
- Ocean Gear Rental Package: **\$100** (BCD, Regulator, Alternate, Dive Computer, 7mm Dive suit, Hooded Vest)

Dive Package:

- Avalon, Catalina 2-Day Weekend: **\$249** (Lodging, Transport to Dive Park, Parking, Food, Air Fills & Gratuity NOT included, approximately \$150 additional)
- Catalina Dive Park 1-day: **\$149** (Food, Water, & Air Fills NOT included---Gratuity-Additional)

***Note: One Dive Package is required for Full Certification unless being referred elsewhere. See Course schedule to determine Dive Package.**

Specialties Offered

Altitude Diver

2 Dives

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving at altitudes between 1000 feet and 10,000 feet using the Recreational Dive Planner.

Equipment Specialist

This course covers the operation and maintenance of equipment. It is not an equipment repair course.

National Geographic 2 Dives

This course discusses underwater exploration, navigation, and maneuvering along a delicate reef system.

Deep Diver 4 Dives

This course covers the skills, knowledge, planning, and techniques of diving between the depths of 60 and 130 feet.

Dry Suit Diver 2 Dives

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving with a dry suit.

Night Diver 3 Dives

This course covers the knowledge and techniques of night diving.

U/W Naturalist 2 Dives

This course discusses how to create awareness, evoke a sense of responsibility, and expand the public's knowledge of the aquatic environment.

AWARE Coral Reef

This course covers information about coral reef distribution, diversity, formation and ecology.

Fish Identification 2 Dives

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for identifying fish common to the local area.

Sea Signs

This course covers the techniques and application of using sign language to communicate in the underwater realm.

U/W Navigator 3 Dives

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of underwater navigation.

Dive Computer 2 Dives

This course covers the skills and knowledge of using a dive computer.

Enriched Air Diver

This course covers the knowledge, skills and techniques for diving with enriched air.

Search & Recovery 4 Dives

This course covers the techniques and application of a variety of search and recovery methods.

Wreck Diver 4 Dives

This course discusses planning, organization, and techniques in utilizing the use of lights, air supplies, penetration lines, reels limited-visibility diving techniques and emergency procedures

Boat Diver 2 Dives

This course covers the skills, knowledge, and techniques of diving from a boat.

Multilevel Diver 2 Dives

This course covers the knowledge and techniques of multilevel diving.

P. P. B. 2 Dives

The purpose of this course is to assist all divers in polishing their buoyancy control

U/W Photographer 2 Dives

This course covers basic underwater photography with special emphasis on practical photographic techniques.

Diver Propulsion Vehicle 2 Dives

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for diving with an underwater propulsion vehicle.

Project Aware


This course covers information about aquatic ecosystem degradation along with conservation measures to protect aquatic resources.

U/W Hunter 2 Dives

This course covers the knowledge and techniques for hunting fish common to the local area. Also preparation of the game you took.
