

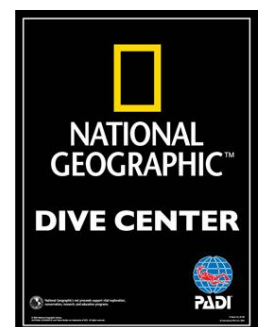


Instructor Development Course

After completion of the IDC, a candidate will have achieved a high level of personal diving skill, instructor-level knowledge of diving theory, significant training in instructor assistance during training activities, and will be able to assume a role of responsibility for the welfare of other divers in his/her charge.

Required Materials:

- PADI IDC Crew pack w/ digital Inst. Manual: **\$535**
- Compass, Timing Device, Dive Knife, Slate and Whistle
- Other materials are required for those who sign up for the course

Prerequisite for Course:

- Certified within the last two years in First Aid and CPR.
- Certified PADI Advanced Open Water Diver or equivalent rating
- Certified Rescue Diver or equivalent rating
- Certified Divemaster or equivalent rating
- Obtain valid CPR Training current for duration of course
- Obtain completed Medical Form valid for duration of course
 - *Mandatory before any in water training occurs*
- Supply all Scuba Equipment required for the course
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Completed 100 logged dives
- DAN O2 Oxygen Administration

Required Gear:

- For class pool sessions and dives, you must supply a Total Scuba Diving System including: BCD, Regulator, Alternate Air Source, Dive Computer or Submersible Pressure Gauge.
